Drivers Awareness Instructor

DESCRIPTION: Prepares students to return to their respective agencies and implement a comprehensive eight-hour, slow-speed, in-service driving awareness training course for peace officers who regularly operate motor vehicles. Classroom and track instruction includes Course Management, Adult Learning Concepts, Performance Evaluation Techniques, Safety Protocols, Legal Issues, Defensive Driving, Pre-Shift Inspections, Vehicle Dynamics, Vehicle Control Techniques and Reverse Driving Practical Applications. Students learn both teaching and driving concepts. Students also perform classroom and driving teaching skills.

Practical application includes specific slow speed driving skills and focuses heavily on vehicle backing. Required in addition to a 40-hour EVOC course to teach in the basic police academy.

REGISTRATION: Registration can be completed 24/7 online at www.nvccjtc.org. Click on Class Schedule and then select the course using the link on the schedule. Payment requires a credit card processed via Eventbrite. No other forms of payment are available. Payment in full is required at the time of reservation. Reservations are made on a "first-paid, first- reserved" basis.

CANCELLATION/ REFUND POLICY: Cancellations received 30 business days prior to the first day of class are eligible for a full refund (less Eventbrite processing fees). All fees are non-refundable within 30 business days of the first day of class. This class requires a minimum enrollment of students. Should the class be cancelled, students will be notified 30 business days prior to the first day of class.

PARKING: A parking permit is not required for exempt vehicles. A daily \$2.00 parking permit is required for all other vehicles. Permits can be purchased from parking machines located in the parking lots. Students may not park in any area painted orange or marked as STAFF parking. This includes marked and un-marked police vehicles.

LAPTOP: Students must bring a laptop computer with wireless internet capabilities. Course materials will be provided to students on a USB drive.
