



LGBT Awareness for Law Enforcement Training for Trainers

DESCRIPTION: This course prepares instructors to facilitate LGBT awareness training as specified in California Penal Code section 13519.41 (effective January 1, 2019) for peace officers, dispatchers and other law enforcement professionals. The learning outcomes for this course include:

1. The student will identify the required course content for LGBT awareness training pursuant to California Penal Code section 13519.41.
2. The student will understand how to use learning activities to deliver course content related to LGBT awareness training for law enforcement.
3. The student will identify the documents required to get a course of training certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.

Participants will have access to a complete training package for the LGBT Awareness For Law Enforcement course including a student workbook and the instructor guide with course outlines, lesson plans, and learning activities (all in PDF format) and hard copy textbook. This course is presented in partnership with Out To Protect Inc.

DATES: Monday, August 7, 2023 from 8AM to 5PM.

COST: \$100 includes course fees and materials.

LOCATION: Napa Valley College, Room 1013.

CERTIFICATIONS: P.O.S.T Certified - Plan IV, Provides 8 hours of CPT credit.

Attire: Professional business casual attire required. Smoking, vaping, and use of all tobacco products is prohibited on campus.

LGBT Law Enforcement Liaison Course

DESCRIPTION: This course prepares students to develop and operate an LGBT Law Enforcement Liaison program. The learning outcomes for this course include:

- Identify key tasks and responsibilities of the LGBT Liaison.
- Identify and cultivate communication pathways between the LGBT Liaison and community.
- Identify key stakeholders, individuals and organizations, to initiate and bolster effective relationships.
- Design community events to build trust between law enforcement and the LGBTQ+ community.

This course is provided by the Napa Valley College Criminal Justice Training Center in partnership with Out To Protect.
